*ASSESSMENTS ~ This week students will be completing end of the year individual reading skill assessments in our classroom ~ sight words, chunks/word families, and decoding words. Students will also be working on some end of the year whole group assessments ~ editing, noun/verb, and handwriting. Please be sure students eat a good breakfast and are well rested.

*One of the reading assessments that students will take this week is on ipads. The HMH growth measure is a reading assessment program which provides immediate, actionable data on student's reading levels and growth over time. HMH helps educators differentiate instruction, make meaningful interventions, forecast growth toward grade-level state tests, and demonstrate accountability.

*THE K-3 MUSIC PROGRAM "IT'S A HIT" will be on Tuesday, May 6th at 2:30 and 7:00 p.m. Doors open at 2:15 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. For the evening performance, students may be dropped off in their CLASSROOMS beginning at 6:45 p.m. Parents must accompany each student to their room and sign them in before the performance and return to their child's classroom after the performance to sign them out. If students have been assigned a part that requires a costume, please plan to bring/wear the costume to school for the afternoon show and again in the evening. If a student doesn't have an assigned costume, please have them plan to wear black or blue pants or a skirt, and dark colored
