## REGULAR BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING

The Board of Education of Independent School District #599 met in regular session at 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, December 11, 2018. Chairman Erickson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Rasch moved, Strem seconded to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting, November 13, 2018. UC

Stola moved, Stuhaug seconded to approve the agenda as presented/amended. UC

Discussion: Levy and Budget

Stuhaug moved, Strem seconded to approve payment of the December bills in the amount of \$413,461.44, for checks 61742-61850 and 2896-2908. UC

Stuhaug moved, Strem seconded to cast votes for Sarah Bauck, MREA Representatives for the North Central Zone. UC

Kaste introduced, Stola seconded the following resolution:

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING COMBINED POLLING PLACES
FOR MULTIPLE PRECINCTS AND
DESIGNATING HOURS DURING WHICH THE POLLING
PLACES WILL REMAIN OPEN FOR VOTING
FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTIONS NOT HELD
ON THE DAY OF A STATEWIDE ELECTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Independent School District No.599, State of Minnesota, as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.11, the precincts and polling places for school district elections are those precincts or parts of precincts located within the boundaries of the school district which have been established by the cities or towns located in whole or in part within the school district. The board hereby confirms those precincts and polling places so established by those municipalities.
- 2. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.11, the board may establish a combined polling place for several precincts for school district elections not held on the day of a statewide election. Each combined polling place must be a polling place that has been designated **for use as a polling place** by a county or municipality. The following combined polling places are established to serve the precincts specified for all school district special and general elections not held on the same day as a statewide election **in the calendar year following the adoption of this resolution**:

(Set forth each combined polling place explaining which precincts are being served, such as:)

Combined Polling Place: <u>Duane Knutson Community Center, City of Fertile- 101 S. Mill St., Fertile, MN</u> 56540

"This combined polling place serves all territory in Independent School District No.599 located in Garden, Garfield, Godfrey, Grove Park Tilden, Liberty, Onstad, Reis, Russia, and Scandia Township; the City of Beltrami; the City of Fertile; Polk County, Minnesota."

Note: See Section 2.3.2 of the Election Manual regarding changing polling places in the case of an emergency or if the polling place is no longer available.

\*3. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.09, the polling places will remain open for voting for school district elections not held on the same day as a statewide election between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m.

Note: See Section 3.6 of the Election Manual regarding certain restrictions on voting hours.

- 4. The clerk is directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the county auditors of each of the counties in which the school district is located, in whole or in part, within thirty (30) days after its adoption.
- 5. As required by Minnesota Statutes, Section 204B.16, Subdivision 1a, the clerk is hereby authorized and directed to give written notice of new polling place locations to each affected household with at least one registered voter in the school district whose school district polling place location has been changed. The notice must be a nonforwardable notice mailed at least twenty-five (25) days before the date of the first election to which it will apply. A notice that is returned as undeliverable must be forwarded immediately to the appropriate county auditor, who shall change the registrant's status to "challenged" in the statewide registration system.

(<u>If a combined polling place is changed</u>, the change must be adopted at least ninety (90) days prior to the first election where it will be used unless that polling place has become unavailable for use.) **This date is November 14, 2018, for an election on February 12, 2019.** 

Note: A resolution similar to this model resolution must be adopted by December 31 of each year, and the combined polling places specified shall be the combined polling places for the following calendar year.
