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***RECIPES** ~ Last week's recipes were a huge success! Thanks to everyone at home who helped prepare your child for the demonstration. The second graders did an amazing job and the class sure enjoyed all the wonderful sampling. It was fun to see our future chefs at work! Thanks again!

***CATERPILLARS** ~ So far we have found that our caterpillars grow about $\frac{1}{2}$ centimeter per day. We note their growth and physical changes on our Butterfly Life Cycle log!

***ASSESSMENTS** ~ This week students will be completing end of the year individual reading skill assessments in our classroom ~ sight words, chunks/word families, and decoding words. Students will also be working on some end of the year whole group assessments ~ editing, noun/verb, and handwriting. Please be sure students eat a good breakfast and are well rested.

*One of the reading assessments that students will take this week is on ipads. The **HMH growth measure** is a reading assessment program which provides immediate, actionable data on student's reading levels and growth over time. HMH helps educators differentiate instruction, make meaningful interventions, forecast growth toward grade-level state tests, and demonstrate accountability.

***THE K-3 MUSIC PROGRAM "IT'S A HIT"** will be on Tuesday, May 6th at 2:30 and 7:00 p.m. Doors open at 2:15 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. For the evening performance, students may be dropped off in their **CLASSROOMS** beginning at 6:45 p.m. Parents must accompany each student to their room and sign them in before the performance and return to their child's classroom after the performance to sign them out. If students have been assigned a part that requires a costume, please plan to bring/wear the costume to school for the afternoon show and again in the evening. If a student doesn't have an assigned costume, please have them plan to wear black or blue pants or a skirt, and dark colored shoes/socks. A **FALCON MUSIC SHIRT** will be provided to wear for both performances. These shirts will stay at school to be used for future programs.

Monday -

- *Students wrote a rough draft of a poem about their MOMS for Mother's Day.
- *Second graders practiced identifying cause and effect in sentences.
- *Spelling words were introduced by students sorting the words into two categories ~ *base/root words* and *(re-) prefix with base/root word*. Students also played a game to review meanings of each.
- *During math students worked on the End of the Year Cumulative Math Test.
- *Second graders read a Scholastic News about insects called cicadas.

- *Students will blend sounds to read words beginning with the prefix *re-*. Students will act out words to review meanings.

- *Second graders will practice identifying cause and effect in sentences.

- *Students will listen to the book, "I Wish I Were a Butterfly". Then they will write a short summary of the story.
- *Second graders will work on their Caterpillar/Butterfly Unit this afternoon.

- *Second graders will practice identifying cause and effect in sentences.

- *Students will continue working with the book "I Wish I Were a Butterfly". They will write a new title for the story and write/draw about their favorite part.
- *Second Graders will enjoy reading the fun message written by a friend as part of a May Day tradition.
