Here's a little bit about what we have planned for the month of April:

Tour of the Waukon Dairy Farm-CANCLED DUE TO TOUR CLOSURES All Groups

We are very excited for this activity! Waukon Dairy is located along Highway 200 east of Gary. It's an impressive dairy farm that has a large milking carousel which runs almost nonstop, milking cows twice a day, 120 or so at a time. We will spend 1-1.5 hours there. The first half hour will be inside in the tour hall and the remainder will be back in the barns seeing the calves and cows.

Make sure your child is dressed for the weather and has footwear you don't mind getting dirty! I highly suggest mud boots if you have.

For pick-up, depending how long the tour gets, we may return later than 5:30. $2^{nd} \& 3^{rd}$ Grade will tour on Wednesday the 3^{rd} 4^{th} , 5^{th} AND 6^{th} will tour on Thursday the 4^{th}

*Students will need a waiver of liability signed by you if they plan on attending. If they do not have this sheet signed by the day of the outing, they will not be able to join us.
